# To develop your knowledge, skills, and confidence throughout the course, you will participate in:

## What is the structure and duration?

Held predominately online, the course is delivered via 12 half-day facilitated sessions, held weekly with 6-week breaks between modules for assessment. You will complete four Module Assessments over typically 9-12 months, depending on your circumstances and time constraints.

## Am I eligible?

To be eligible to complete this course, you must:

- Be an Australian or New Zealand citizen or permanent resident
- Demonstrate a minimum level of Language, Literacy & Numeracy (LLN)
- Have at least one-year experience as a project manager or team member responsible for managing a component of a project
- Have one or more work-based projects in progress during the course to enable concepts and practices to be applied in the workplace.

Learners must have at least 1 year of experience working on projects, so our course is about 1/2 the standard timeframe!

## About the assessment

You will complete four module assessments over 9-12 months containing assessment tasks, including knowledge questions, case study project documentation, work-based project documentation, and a reflective analysis exploring PM practices within your organisation.

## **Hours of study**

- 48 hours of training (12 x 4-hour sessions)
- 64 hours (8 days) of independent work on assessment tasks, such as completing activities started in training, research and reading, answering knowledge questions, and collating work-based evidence.
- The remaining hours in this course overlap with the your work, as you apply concepts, processes, tools and techniques to work-based projects in accordance with your organisation's PM methodology, if there is one.
